#### P-1801 STRAIT OF GEORGIA - "WG"

#### P-1922 CAPTAINS PASSAGE

Activated:0701 30 Oct 2006

A derelict vessel has been reported in position 48 50.85N 123 24.75W ( between Nose Pt. and Peille Pt.)

This derelict is considered a hazard to navigation and mariners transitting the area are urged to exercise caution.
